Diploma and Training Equivalence Review Steps to Follow and Fees

All fees are given in Canadian currency.

1. Documentation and Eligibility Review

The Order will first do a preliminary review of any documentation you have provided, including any diplomas in occupational therapy you may have, in order to assess your eligibility to practice in Quebec. The Order may then establish your level of equivalence based on this review, and may instruct you to follow a training program, as described below.

Fees: \$1,045 + taxes (\$52.25 GST + \$82.29 QST) = **\$1,179.54**

2. Panel Review

Further to its preliminary review, the admissions committee may request a panel review of your qualifications. If that is the case, you will first have an interview with the admissions coordinator, and then move on to the panel review over 2 nonconsecutive half days.

The Order will then establish your level of equivalence and may instruct you to follow a training program, as described below

Fees: \$885 + taxes (\$44.25 GST + \$69.69 QST) = **\$998.94**

3. Training Program

This custom training program is designed by the Order to help you achieve the required equivalence level based on your current competencies. As such, you must successfully complete it, and may include supervised practical training in a clinical setting and university courses.

- Supervised practical training:

Fees paid to the Order:

\$100 + taxes (\$5.00 GST + \$7.88 QST) = **\$112.88 per practical training**

Fees paid to the supervising authority:

\$40 + taxes (\$2.00 GST + \$3.15 QST) = **\$45.15 per week of practical training**

- University courses: course fees paid to the university

4. Licence

Once your qualifications and training meet the requirements set by the Order, you will receive a regular licence, or a temporary licence if you do not yet show that you have a working knowledge of the French language.

Fees: \$75 + taxes (\$3.75 GST + \$5.91 QST) = **\$84.66**

5. Registration as a Member of the Order

The law states that any person who wishes to use the title “occupational therapist” or to engage in any professional activity restricted to occupational therapists must have a valid licence issued by the Order and must be entered on its roll of registered members. Please note that registration with the Order requires payment of annual membership dues.
